

# COMMUNITY TRADE YARD INCOME INCREASING PROJECT MENTAL HEALTH CAMPAIGN OF BAN DOK DAENG MOO 5, BANGSAI, TAKUAPA, PHANG-NGA PROVINCE

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Ban Dok Daeng is a community that has economic plantations such as oil palms, rubber plantations, and orchards. The main occupation in the community is farmers. After the epidemic situation of COVID-19 impacts in the following areas:

- 1.Environmental impact
- 2.Social impact
- 3.Economic impact
- 4.Health impact



Ban Dok Daeng created a community trading yard project to increase income by aiming to make it a village-level trading yard. Previously, the village did not have a trading yard or product center or product exchange center. The community has planned to choose a location for the trading yard to be easily accessible. Setting a sales date, planning, and having a system for product quality control as specified. Operating steps are as the following :

- 1.Preparation phase: A village committee was established to plan and work, solve problems, and monitor the performance of occupation classes.
- 2.Operation phase: Started with an activity to educate the community on the economic changes of the community after the outbreak of COVID-19 and how to create online media to get a great sales volume. There will be lecturers giving lectures, organizing the training activities to enhance the skills of soil planting and weaving.



## Results

1. 50 affected people participated in training to enhance their skills and knowledge about making soil for planting.
2. 50 affected people participated in training to enhance basketry skills.
3. 80% of affected people who are unemployed have a career.
4. 50% of the affected people had their debt reduced.

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
