developed students to be organizers of positive condom communication activities for elementary and high school students in Nakhon Si Thammarat Province.

Organized activities on 4 topics: 1) Change and growth 2) Sexual health crossword 3) Positive condom communication in the form of open-minded dialogue with siblings. 4) Solving questions for effective prevention of disease and instilling condom use values among adolescents to have knowledge, courage, and use of condoms.

Students have developed self-healing skills by strengthening positive energy through being leaders in organizing creative activities to reduce risky behaviors.

Student leaders 53-person condom positive communication student leaders were born. Student leaders were able to organize positive condom communication activities for 5,946 students aged 10-15 years old in schools. Students have developed self-healing skills by strengthening positive energy through being leaders in organizing creative activities to reduce risky behaviors. Students have access to an international source of condom support through communication channel 1663.
