TEACHING & LEARNING

- A total of 7 Thai and 8 International students join in this upskill project
- Five important aspects of captive population management: Husbandry, zoo design and management, restraint, sample collection, and animal health in zoos and other captive (ex-situ) facilities.
- Five important aspects of habitat population management are covered: Sanctuary facilities, animal trapping, sample collection, wild life behavior, and wild life research in the field (in-situ).

- Four In situ facilities (3 from governments and 1 from non-governments)
- Three veterinary collage for International zoo and wildlife network (Thailand-Australia-South Korea)
