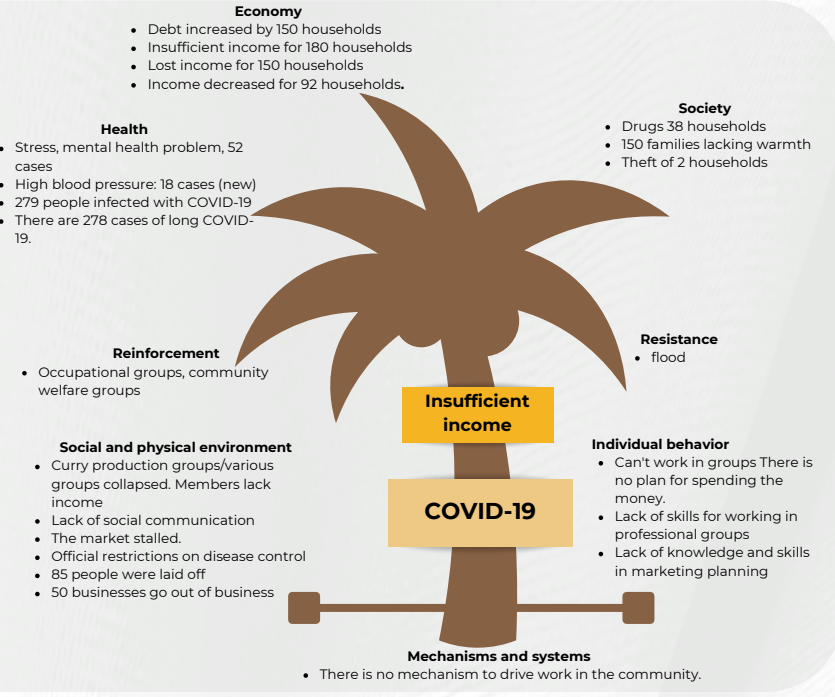

CONTENT STORY

The Ban Pa Yang Community consists of 873 individuals (285 households).



01

A group of leaders has been formed with knowledge and skills to promote health and reduce the impact of the COVID-19 outbreak in the community.

- There are 15 project committee members, covering two groups of leaders.
- The committee has 95 percent of data management skills for project development.
- Leaders have knowledge about improving health through crises, 80 percent

02

A mechanism has emerged to drive health promotion work and reduce the impact of the outbreak.

- The committee follows up and evaluates operations every month.
- There are at least 2 professional groups.
- Monthly work results are recorded 8 times.
- There are records of 8 monthly performance monitoring and evaluation committee meetings.
- Follow-up and evaluation of results occurred 3 times.

- 01** Community project orientation (14/01/66)
- 02** Meeting to explain project implementation to household representatives (09/02/66)
- 03** 4 out of 10 project implementation committee meetings (16/01/66, 13/02/66, 18/03/66 and 08/04/66)
- 04** Exchange knowledge among members of the curry group and assess the mental health of members. (22/02/66)
- 08** Survey to set up a group to grow vegetables and supply the curry paste group (01/03/66)
- 08** Follow up to evaluate results for learning and development (ARE) 2 out of 3 times. (18,20/05/66)

Better quality of life

- 90 percent of those affected had better mental health.
- Those affected have better relationships with each other, 90 percent.
- Those affected had an 80 percent increase in income.
- Unemployed people have more jobs by 80 percent.
- Group members' income increased by 90 percent.

The government agency is the Phra Phrom District Public Health Office and Phra Phrom Hospital, Phra Phrom Agricultural Office, Tai Sampao Subdistrict Administrative Organization, Community development work, Village funds, and savings groups.
