1 Situation



Ban Thong Kong Kang Community have youth outside the educational system, unemployed and elderly people. But there have resources and potential regarding fishing and seafood processing. From this situation, people used resources and potential to manage in the community to be able to drive work.

Target population:

Participants: 100 people of youth outside the educational system, Unemployed and elderly people.

Facilitator: 50 people of Walailak University team, Ban Bon Noen Subdistrict Hospital, Southern College of Technology, Pak Phanang District Community Development.

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3 Procedure:



1. preparation of life plan consisting of 3 plans and 2 courses (career plan, financial plan, health plan, mental care course and saving courses)
2. Developed professional skills to create a core concept of knowledge and can be applied. (fish processing and processing the southern curry paste from Pak Phanang)

Outcome:

- 80% of Participants have life skill and career development, good financial management and saving and improve their own and their families' health.
- have 2 online markets for professional groups, 90% of career development products are sold in local and online markets.
- have extra income average of 5,000 baht per group.

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
